

**MICHIGAN ENTERPRISES REPORT NO. ONE HUNDRED EIGHTEEN
TO LINCOLN DDA**

The following is a report by Bob Jones of Michigan Enterprises for the Lincoln DDA concerning July activity on major projects: We keep specifics confidential to board members and a few select others until project owners wish to release any information.

1. SENIOR ASSISTED LIVING

Missy was scheduled to meet yesterday with her architect to go over prices for her Lincoln facility. She is keeping me informed, looking ahead to see if an October groundbreaking is still on schedule. I may know at the DDA meeting.

2. DOLLAR GENERAL

Charles Overton of Dollar General keeps changing his schedule but is still promising to come to Lincoln yet this month. Hopefully I will know more by the DDA meeting.

3. ENERGY

My latest word on the status of the Viking Energy contract to stay open is that the parent company owner, Engie, put off negotiating with the Hillman facility until all three facility power purchase agreements would fall due on the same date and that would be good for both Consumers Power and the three biomass power plants in Lincoln, McBain, and Hillman. That date is December 31, 2018, and it can be extended for all three facilities.

4. COOPER STANDARD

I heard from Kevin Brady of Cooper Standard recently this week that he is scheduling a date yet this summer when he will be coming north and he will definitely have Lincoln on his agenda. More on this at the DDA meeting.

5. TRAVERSE BAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

I have been in touch with Phil on possibilities for improving funding for a streetscape on the east end of Traverse Bay Street. Phil may have an update report on this.
