1. SENIOR ASSISTED LIVING

Missy (company owner) is still looking to visit Lincoln soon, but has not set a date. Maybe by meeting time.

I have made contact with a good referral person, who knows most of the other assisted living owners. I will tell more at the meeting.

2. DOLLAR GENERAL

I have had some good conversations with Charles Overton, the Dollar General site search person, We're getting close to a favorable verdict for Lincoln. More at the meeting.

3. VIKING ENERGY

We're making headway on getting public support for keeping Viking open. I got a long front page story in the Cadillac News on the McBain cogen, as the break through move on getting the story out to the people in the state of Michigan. I will bring copies of the story to the meeting. I have talked with Mr. Spencer of the Alpena News, and have a meeting with him on Tuesday before our DDA meeting as the second leg of our story, and the next leg after that will be the Traverse City Record Eagle, then others like the Lansing and Flint papers, culminating with the Detroit Free Press.

4. COOPER STANDARD

Kevin Brady of Cooper Standard thinks he will be up north this summer and will visit Lincoln then. If it looks like another Cooper Standard guy will make the north visit, then Kevin will meet with me in their Novi head office. More on that at DDA meeting.
