

**MICHIGAN ENTERPRISES REPORT NUMBER ONE HUNDRED SIX
TO LINCOLN DDA**

The following is a report by Bob Jones of Michigan Enterprises for the Lincoln DDA concerning July activity on major projects, the proposed Senior (Assisted) Living facility, and now Dollar Tree/General. We want to keep specifics confidential until project owners wish to release any information.

1. NEW SENIOR ASSISTED LIVING COMPANY

Dennis Kruttlin and I have been in contact with the new assisted living company representative. The company is willing to sign a letter of development outlining the obligations of each party – the Lincoln DDA and the company. The company has selected their attorney to represent them in this endeavor and has made him known to us. The process has begun, but has been slowed down due to medical matters with our attorney Dave Cook. Dennis is on top of this and we will proceed as soon as Dave is able, which should be soon.

2. DOLLAR GENERAL/TREE

Dollar General has put the Lincoln site on hold until the first of 2018, when new sites will be taken up for study. I will be on top of this date and will follow up soon after January 1, 2018 as possible.

In the mean time I have been in touch with the Dollar Tree representative for the Midwest area. He has contacted me after playing phone tag for two weeks. He left a voice message on my phone telling me that he is the representative for our area and will be contacting me soon. That was last week. I will again follow up with a call to him again. This is standard procedure of contacting people today, especially with a person who represents nine states and part of Ontario, Canada. We have to have persistence and patience, which I have learned only too well, especially on large projects with large companies.
